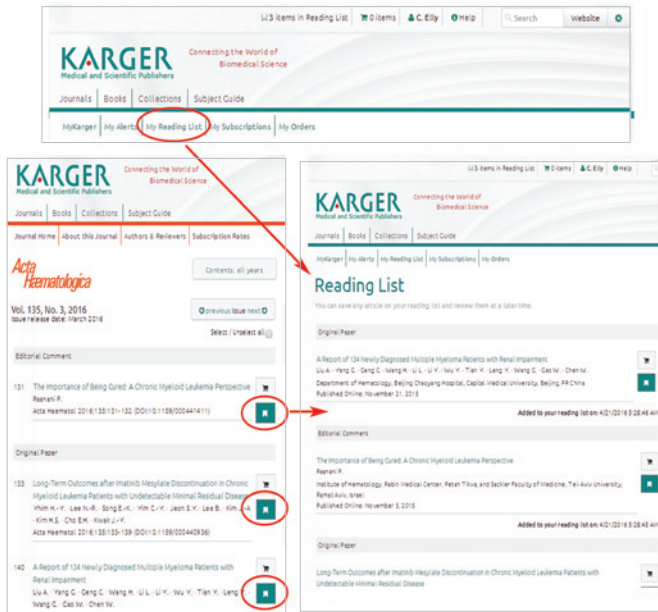

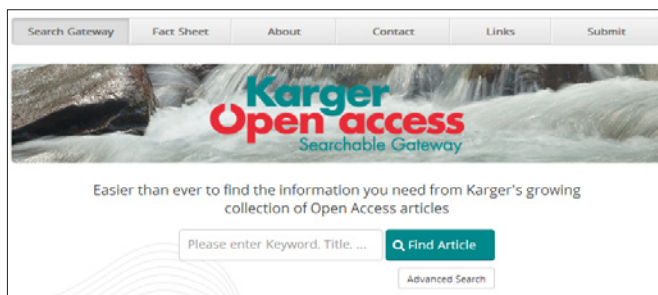

Karger content can also be found in Bing, Yahoo and search engines such as EBSCO Discovery Service. ePartnerships with major industry databases and service providers such as SCOPUS; Thomson Reuters ISI Web of Knowledge; PubMed/Medline; CrossRef; Mendeley and ExLibris maximize linking of top-quality medical content.

- **Medline/PubMed:** Nearly all Karger journals and most book series are listed in Medline/Pubmed.
- **Google:** Karger content is also discoverable via Google Scholar and Google Books.

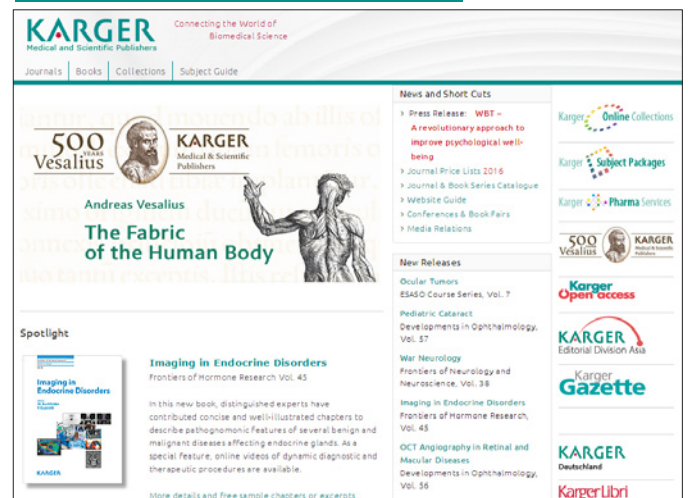

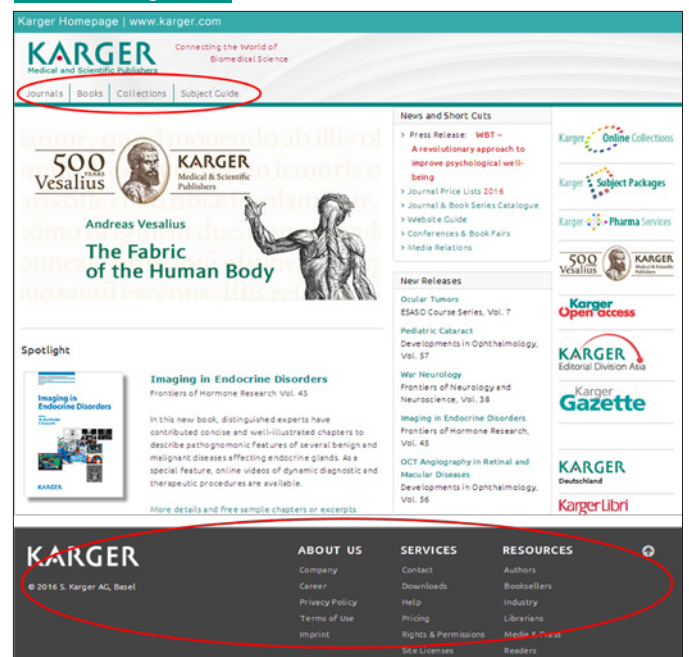

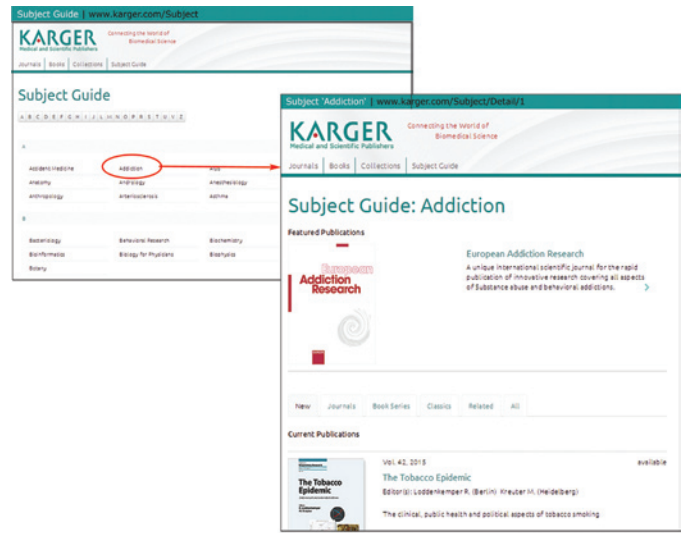

Journals

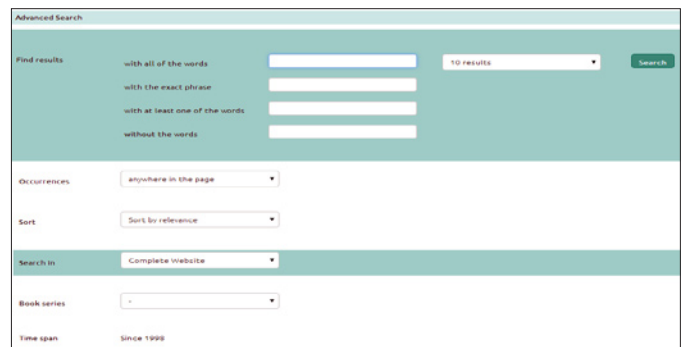
Karger's list of approximately 100 highly respected journal titles spans the entire spectrum of biomedical specialties.

- All active journals are listed at www.karger.com/Journal. For discontinued journals and title changes, please see "Inactive Journals" in the navigation to the right.
- At the journal homepage, you may directly access to all issues: online first, current issues, back volumes (from 1998) and journal archive issues (from first year of publication through 1997).
- All articles are available in HTML and /or PDF format.
- Most Karger articles are published online first and are fully citable.
- Citations can be easily downloaded as Text-file and RIS- file.
- PubMed ID shown with a link to the article in PubMed.
- The link to CCC RightsLink is available for instant contents re-use permission request.
- References include links to external resources (PubMed/ MEDLINE, CrossRef) providing immediate access to the original sources.



Search

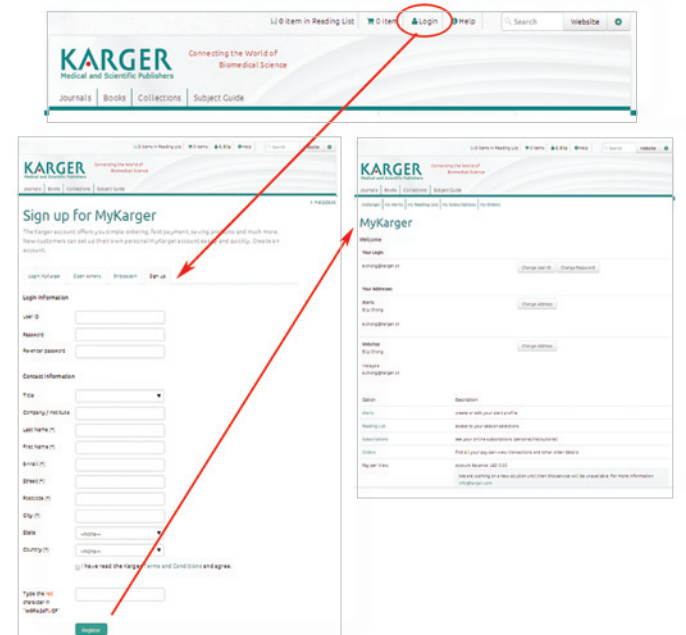

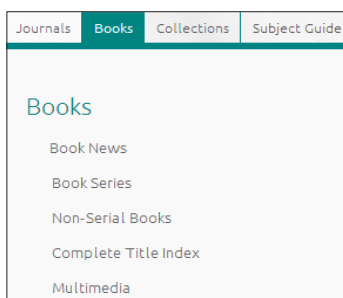
- **My Alerts:** Choose Alerts by field of interest or from the journals and book series list, allowing you to receive alerts for journal issue releases or alerts for new online articles.



Books

Karger books cover a broad range of biomedical topics and most of those published since 1997 are available as eBooks.

- Book News: Previews upcoming and quarterly book releases.
- Book Series: Lists all active book series.
- Non-Serial Books: List of all non-series books including hard-cover reprints and special or supplement journal issues.
- Complete Title Index: Current series and non-series program, with a separate option to show all book publications since 1890.
- Multimedia: lists all CD-ROMs, audio and video available separately.



Subject Guide

List of biomedical specialties and subspecialties as well as related scientific areas are arranged in alphabetical order. Each specialty is divided into new publications, journals, book series, classics, related and all publications in the field.
