Ruth later remembered the fast way she saved her sister's life. She had noticed that her sister, who was ill, had begun to *strangle*. She quickly called her mother. After a *useless effort* to help Joan, Mrs. Ginsburg handed the baby to Ruth and rushed to phone for help. The baby *appeared* to have stopped breathing.

Ruth suddenly decided to start breathing into the baby's mouth. Later, Ruth explained that she remembered a newspaper story her mother once read to her about a life being saved by mouth-to-mouth breathing.

"So I thought it might work with Joan," she said.
